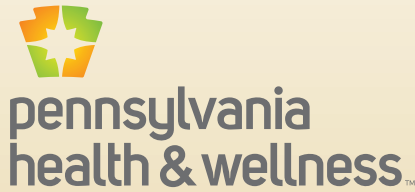


Program Objectives
